DIRECTIONS to Kingston Downs, Kingston, GA:

Travel Interstate Highway I-75 to exit 293 (Hwy 411 and turn towards the Holiday Inn. You will be traveling Southwest heading into Cartersville. Pass the Holiday Inn and drive four (4) miles to US Hwy 41 (also Cobb Parkway and also Joe Frank Harris Pkwy). Hwy 411 South and US 41 North travel together with Hwy 41 heading North and Hwy 411 call South towards Rome. You will need to take the right ramp onto 41 North/411 South at the Huddle House and travel about three (3) miles following 41 North and 411 South towards Rome. Take the 411 South hwy ramp towards Rome and travel ten and a half (10.5) miles to Kingston Downs, at mile marker 1. Kingston Downs is on your right directly on Hwy 411. There will be Atlanta Steeplechase signs at that point. Show your pass to enter the event site then drive to the Will Call Tent and exchange your pass for a Steeplechase pass to park infield track and unload. The Equestrian events starts after 12 noon and the track is open on 15 minute intervals for the rest of the day.

Drive directly to the Will Call Tent and show this pass for the Atlanta Steeplechase parking pass. Placing the “Atlanta Steeplechase Will Call parking pass” in your car allows you to park in the infield. As a competitor you will be able to enter the Atlanta Steeplechase at no cost, bring your competition dogs, and park for free fairly close to the competition field inside the 60 acre race track. You must have this pass to enter the park free, and bring a Frisbee disc to show you are competing. Anyone in your car will receive a free entry pass as well. This is an equestrian event so please keep your dogs away from the horses and away from the track fence line.
